**APPROVAL OF MINUTES** Without objections the Minutes were approved. Secretary, Noland Hill, was not in attendance so Mindy Rockwell sat in as Secretary.

**TREASURER'S REPORT** Report was given by Steve Ferrell.

Without objections, the Treasurer's Report was approved.

**WEG** Paid out \$1,220.00 for the 16 days. We had three (3) temp employees: Samantha Deegan, Ken Hall, Shaun Hubbard.  
\$194.00 was total income  
\$66.00 was donation  
\$127.00 from merchandise sold

It was worth having a worker there. Recouped 10% of expenses. 1,072 visitors came to the museum and most were from out of the country.

300 badges – full size WEG badges were sold to police.

#### **PLAN for 2011**

Dave Hume wants to pay \$10.00 an hour for four (4) hours on Saturdays and close on Sundays.

#### **MISCELLANEOUS**

Horse drawn wagon needs to be moved. Jim Caton will store at his farm about 30 miles down the road. Steve Ferrell will get wrecker to move it.

Mrs. Selby may be willing to offer some money to the museum.

Southland Auction -- \$105.00 paid from auction house; \$78.75 we cleared after commission.

Three (3) trustees were brought in to clean the museum top to bottom a week before WEG. Thanks go to Noland Hill for that. Can get them back should we need them.

No heat is a possibility so may have to close for January/February.

No information on brick yet. Mindy Rockwell will check on this.

Vote was taken to paint the red display case a different color and there was a unanimous vote to do so.

Can come in at noon to 4:00 p.m. instead of 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
